

“Card in a Card” Instructions

1. Print [outside.jpg](#) on one side of a piece of card or photo paper, and [inside.jpg](#) on the other side, so that the card is double-sided printed

2. Cut around the outside of the card

3. Cut out the aperture on the front / inside-left of the card.

Photo to the right shows the inside of the card, with the aperture cut out (inside-left). Do not cut the white rectangle on the inside-right of the card.



4. Print [inner card.jpg](#) and cut out [Inner Card](#) and [Inner Card Insert](#).

5. Fold [Inner Card](#) down the middle so that it turns into a card with a blank inside

6. Fold [Inner Card Insert](#) down the middle and stick it to the inside of [Inner Card](#), so that it covers the white space and provides a pretty insert for you to write your message on.

Use the photo to the right as a guide – you can see that the [Inner Card Insert](#) (stars with a white oval) has been stuck to the inside of [Inner Card](#) (Christmas cookies).



7. Go back to the large card and score down the middle (marked with a thin grey line) and then fold in half.

8. Cover the back of [Inner Card](#) (plain white) with adhesive such as double sided tape or glue, and stick it to the white rectangle on the inside-right of your large card.

9. *Optional*

Print [insert options.jpg](#) if you want to customise your card. Cut out the insert rectangles with messages and stick to the plain oval on the inside of the small card, and use the small rectangular sentiment toppers wherever you want!
