## SUPPLIES LIST

The following two pages contain a supplies list for the Christmas Craft Countdown.

I have deliberately kept the list vague and grouped all supplies together rather than doing "per project" supplies lists so that the craft projects remain a surprise until they are released.

Some of the supplies link to Amazon to give a better idea of the product I am talking about, but other brands/types of the same type of product/item are suitable and most of the supplies should be available in craft stores or from other websites.

# TOOLS & EQUIPMENT

- Cricut machine or similar
- Cricut Maker Knife Blade (optional)
- Cricut scoring wheel or scoring stylus (optional)
- Foam pads (2+ packets)
- Glue (recommended brands: Collall (UK), Art Glitter Glue or Bearly Art Glue)
- Glue gun
- Heat press / Cricut EasyPress / iron
- Light blue Cricut cutting mat
- Scissors
- Sticky tape

## CARDSTOCK

Many of the projects in the Christmas Craft Countdown are primarily made from cardstock. It's hard to say how much you will need as it depends on the size of card you are using and how big you cut the projects.

The colours you will need most of are are: 4 shades of red, 4 shades of green card (1 sage green, 1 bright green, 2 dark greens), white, 2 shades of brown, pale grey/off-white, gold pearlescent, 2 shades of pale blue

You'll also need some: cream, 2 shades of yellow, pale yellow, skin colour (for Santa), orange, black, bright blue & possibly small amounts of other colours too.

# CRAFT SUPPLIES

- 3-5 square shadow boxes, approx. 20x20cm (DIY your own from card with this [free SVG from Special Heart Studio](#) )
- Acetate (can't find any? Cut up the protective film of an old Cricut mat)
- Adhesive vinyl (black, white and bright colours of your choosing)
- Battery powered tea lights
- Empty transparent glass or plastic cookie jar with lid (or similar)
- Fun foam/funky foam (suggested colours: brown, pink, white, pink)
- Glitter (suggested colours: brown, pink, gold, orange, white)
- Heat Transfer Vinyl (HTV) in Christmas colours
- Lindor (Lindt) and Ferrero Rocher chocolates (or similar)
- Small rose embellishments or similar (or make your own with [this tutorial from Jennifer Maker](#))
- Something to add HTV to, e.g. t-shirt, jumper, tote bag, etc
- Strong hairspray or other way to [make glitter ornaments](#)
- Transparent baubles/ornaments that you can glitter (this is just one part of one of the projects!)
- White circular plate or a circular wooden plaque/round/tray/etc
- White, silver or pale blue ribbon
- White, silver or pale blue sequins or similar
