Family Shadow Box with Personalization

Supplies List

- Cricut machine / Silhouette / ScanNCut
- Light grip cutting mat
- Coloured card (I used 160-240gsm weight of card)
- Collall All Purpose glue or similar
- Needle tip applicator bottle (optional)
- 3D foam pads
- Shadow box (I used a 15x15cm shadow box from Hobbycraft in the UK)



Instructions

- 1 Download the cutting file from the link above and unzip the folder.
- 2 Upload your chosen cutting file into your cutting machine software. For Cricut Design Space you **must** use the files that start with SVG in the filename.
- 3 Add your names or greeting to the ribbon. I used a Cricut Access font called Belwe Std Medium.

Place a star shape at the beginning and end of the ribbon and in between every word. This will give you a solid piece of card to add foam pads to when sticking the layers together to give it more of a “3D” appearance.

- 4 Weld the letters to the red ribbon layer.



- 5 Measure the spacer inside your shadow box frame. Resize the design in your cutting machine software to the size of the spacer.
- 6 Cut out all of the layers from cardstock
- 7 Stick the layers together using a combination of foam pads/squares and glue. There is a file in the download folder called **Assembly Guide.pdf** that shows the order to stick the layers together in.
- 8 Frame the design
