DIY Dog Treat Jar with Vinyl

Supplies List

- Cricut Maker
- Light blue Cricut cutting mat
- Adhesive vinyl in various colours (removeable or permanent)
- A glass or plastic jar with a secure lid
- Something Christmassy to decorate the lid (optional)
- A glue gun (optional)
- Dog treats to fill the jar!



Instructions

- 1 Download the cutting file from the link above and unzip the folder
- 2 Upload the cutting file into your cutting machine software. For Cricut Design Space you **must** use the file called SVG_Dog_Bone_Paw_CraftWithSarah.svg
- 3 Measure your jar and use the "Shapes" tool in Cricut Design Space to make a template that's the size of the sides of your jar.
- 4 Make copies of the pawprint and bone images by clicking on them and pressing the "Duplicate" button. Resize them and place them around your template.
- 5 Use the "Text" button to type out the name of the dog and then change it to a pretty font. Slice the word TREATS out of the dog bone image and position underneath the name. Add any other decorations to the front that you'd like to put on there.



- 6** Colour the designs to the same colours that you will be cutting them from vinyl.
- 7** When you're finished with the design, cut it out from adhesive vinyl. Permanent or removeable vinyl will work.
- 8** Weed the excess vinyl then use transfer tape to stick the vinyl to the jar. Use rubbing alcohol to clear the jar before you stick the vinyl to it. This helps to get rid of any dirt or fingerprints which gives the vinyl a better chance of sticking.
- 9** When you've finished adding the vinyl, fill up the jar with some tasty dog treats! I used Pedigree gravy bones. My dogs LOVE these!
- 10** Use a glue gun to add some Christmas themed decorations to the top of the jar. This step is optional, but it helps to give an extra festive feel to the jar!
