Faux Arabesque Ornaments

Supplies List

- Cricut machine / Silhouette / ScanNCut
- Light grip cutting mat
- Coloured card (I used 160-240gsm weight of card)
- Collall All Purpose glue or similar
- Needle tip applicator bottle (optional)
- 3D foam pads
- Ribbon



Instructions

- 1 Download the cutting files from the link above and unzip the folder
- 2 Upload the cutting files into your cutting machine software. For Cricut Design Space you **must** use the files that start SVG_ in the filename.
- 3 Resize the design. I made my ornaments 3.25 inches tall.
- 4 If you want to make a double-sided ornament then Duplicate the design so that you have two of them.
- 5 Cut out all of the layers from cardstock.
- 6 Stick the layers together using a combination of foam pads/squares and glue. I use foam pads for the first layer and glue for the rest.
- 7 To make a double-sided ornament, use foam pads or glue to stick two matching ornaments back-to-back.
- 8 Thread ribbon through the hole in the top and tie into a bow.
