## DIY Glitter Ornament: Unicorn Face

### Supplies List

- Cricut Maker
- Light blue Cricut cutting mat (for vinyl)
- Strong grip Cricut mat (for foam – optional)
- Cricut knife blade (optional)
- Plastic fillable ornaments
- Fun foam in white, pink and brown/yellow
- Adhesive vinyl (permanent or removable)
- Transfer tape
- Alcohol wipes
- Glue gun
- Small craft flowers
- Extra fine glitter
- Kitchen towel or tissues
- Firm grip hairspray
- Collall All Purpose Glue



# Instructions

- 1** Download the cutting files from the link above and unzip the folder. Upload the cutting files into your cutting machine software. For Cricut Design Space you **must** use the files that start SVG\_ in the filename.
- 2** Remove the top from your ornament and spray hairspray in for about 5 seconds. Swirls it around the fully coat the ornament then drain the excess onto kitchen roll. Pour in glitter and swirl to coat. Pour out excess. Add the top back onto the ornament.
- 3** Measure your ornament and make a circle in Design Space the same size. Use that as a guide to resize the unicorn face design.
- 4** Cut the unicorn facial features from adhesive vinyl and the horn, ears and mane from foam or felt.
- 5** Clean the front of the bauble with an alcohol wipe to remove any dirt or fingerprints. Apply the vinyl to the front of your bauble.
- 6** Use a glue gun to stick the ears, horn and mane to the bauble and then to add flowers around them to make a crown. Thread some ribbon through the hook in the top to finish.
