DIY Shaker Gift Tags

Supplies List

- Cricut Maker
- Light blue Cricut cutting mat (for vinyl)
- Acetate
- Sequins
- Extra fine glitter
- Collall All Purpose Glue
- Needle Tip Applicator Bottle
- Fun foam OR foam tape (optional)
- Strong grip Cricut mat (for foam – optional)
- Cricut knife blade (optional)



Instructions

- 1** Download the cutting file from the link above and unzip the folder
- 2** Add the design to your project and resize it to the size that you want to cut your gift tag. Mine is 4 inches tall and 2.25 inches wide.
- 3** Go into “Images” and find some Christmas pictures to use. Don't overlap the black of the outline of the gift tag. When done, select all the pictures and the gift tag piece and click “Weld” to join the layers together.
- 4** Add text with a drawing font to the front and back.
- 5** Cut out all pieces of the design, including your choice of spacer method (see link at top of page for more info)
- 6** Glue the acetate over the windows. Add your spacer to one side of the tag. Fill the middle with sequins and glitter, then seal up by glueing on the other side of the tag.
