## Fireplace Gift Card Holder

Download the cutting file from [craftwithsarah.com/CCC18](http://craftwithsarah.com/CCC18)

### Supplies List

- Cricut Maker
- Light blue Cricut cutting mat
- Coloured Card (I used 160-240gsm weight of card)
- Collall All Purpose Glue
- Needle Tip Applicator Bottle
- 3D foam pads



# Instructions

- 1 Download the cutting file from the link above and unzip the folder
- 2 Resize the design. For a standard sized gift card/credit card, it should be 7.8 inches wide and 5.383 inches tall.
- 3 Cut out all of the layers from cardstock.
- 4 Glue the holly and clock pieces to the main white piece.
- 5 Fold the red rectangle in half and glue it shut, making sure the gift card holder piece will fit inside.
- 6 Stick all the other pieces to the red rectangle and main white piece.
- 7 Slot your gift card inside the white piece and slide it into the red square piece to make your finished gift card holder.
